

50/50 Raffle Official Rules

Official Rules: By participation in the Foster the Love Louisiana, Inc 50/50 Raffle, (the "Raffle"), entrants agree to be bound by these Official Rules, and the decisions of the Foster the Love Louisiana, Inc., a 501(c)(3) public charity (the "Organization"), which shall be binding and final to the matters related to the Raffle. The Raffle is subject to all applicable federal, state, and local laws and is void where prohibited.

Eligibility: The Raffle is open to all legal residents of the fifty (50) United States and the District of Columbia that are eighteen (18) years of age or older as of the date of the entry ("Eligible Individual"). The Organization has the right to request photo identification from any person desiring to enter the Raffle. Entrants are subject to these Official Rules. Employees, Board Members of the Organization, and their immediate families (spouses, siblings, parents, children, and household members) are not eligible to enter into or participate in the Raffle.

Raffle Process: The total proceeds from Raffle Tickets sold for the Drawing ("Raffle Tickets"), less the reasonable expenses incurred by the Organization for the operation of the Raffle as permitted by law shall be the "Jackpot". The random selection of a unique Raffle Ticket from the total pool of Raffle Tickets purchased in person and online shall be referred to as an individual "Drawing". The Jackpot accumulated for each Drawing will be publicly announced before the Drawing takes place. The Entrant whose Raffle Ticket is randomly selected in the Drawing shall be declared the winner (the "Winner") of that Drawing. For the purpose of clarity, only one (1) Winner may claim the Cash Prize.

Purchasing Raffle Tickets: Raffle Tickets will be available for purchase in-person through members of the Organization or online at www.fosterthelovela.org/raffle February 1-27, 2022.

All Raffle Tickets may be purchased for \$100.00 USD. There are no discounts or complimentary Raffle Tickets. There is no limit to the number of Raffle Tickets an Eligible Individual may purchase. Available Tickets will be limited in number to 200. Each Eligible Individual who purchases a Raffle Ticket(s) (an "Entrant") will receive a receipt corresponding to his/her purchased Raffle Ticket(s). All Raffle Ticket purchases shall be final, and no refunds or replacements will be issued by the Organization. Raffle Tickets are only valid for the Drawing held on the date indicated on the Raffle Ticket.

Proceeds: Prize and Organization. There will be a maximum of one (1) Winner selected during each Drawing. The Winner of each Drawing will, subject to the Official Rules, be awarded fifty percent (50%) of the Jackpot for said Drawing, less any and all applicable taxes or fees (the "Cash Prize"). The remaining proceeds shall be retained by the Organization. Winner assumes all responsibility for any state, county or federal taxes, fees and withholdings. Federal and state withholding laws are subject to change without notice. The withholding laws in effect at the time each Cash Prize is claimed will be

followed. The Cash Prize will be paid to Winner by check within 30 days of the date the Cash Prize is claimed. The Raffle Ticket receipt (paper ticket or email) is the only valid receipt for claiming a prize.

Selection of Winner. The Winner will be announced during a live event via the internet on Monday, February 28th, 2022 at 10:00 AM CST. The Winner shall be randomly selected through the use of random-name-picker.org.

The Organization will immediately contact the Winner via email and phone. The Winner has 30 days, beginning on the date of the Drawing, to claim the Cash Prize ("Claims Period"). Should the 30th day fall on a Saturday, Sunday or recognized holiday, then the Claims Period shall be extended to the immediate following business day. Winner must provide the Organization with all information required to claim the Prize (Ticket Receipt, Identification proof, Social Security Number, etc.) The Organization has no obligation to contact potential Winners beyond initial contact on the day of the Drawing. If the Winner does not claim the Cash Prize within the Claims Period, the Winner will be disqualified, with the Cash Prize being donated to the Organization.

Raffle Tickets are Not Tax Deductible. The IRS has taken the position that the amounts paid for chances to participate in raffles, lotteries or similar programs are not gifts, and therefore, the price of the entry does not qualify as a deductible charitable contribution.

Odds. The odds of a specific Raffle Ticket being the winning Raffle Ticket depends on the total number of Raffle Tickets purchased for the Drawing. This Drawing will be limited to a total sale of 200 tickets.

Transfer of Raffle Tickets or Prize. Entrants may opt to give away their Raffle Tickets to other Eligible Individuals, but in doing so the initial Entrant waives any claim he/she might otherwise have to the Cash Prize. Entrants may not re-sell their Raffle Tickets to other parties, and may not knowingly give Raffle Tickets away to others for the purpose of allowing those other parties to re-sell such Raffle Tickets. All Raffle Tickets which have been resold in violation of these Official Rules shall be ineligible to participate in the Raffle or Drawing to win the Cash Prize. Winner may transfer his/her Cash Prize to a third party provided that the following conditions are met: (a) the transferee would have otherwise been considered an Eligible Individual to enter the Raffle; (b) the transferee shall be responsible for all taxes and costs described in these Official Rules; and (c) the transferee shall be bound by all terms and conditions of these Official Rules that are applicable to the Winner.

Judges. The Raffle will be conducted and supervised by the Organization, whose decisions are final. The Organization reserves the right to modify these Official Rules at any time. The Organization reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to cancel or suspend the Raffle should unauthorized human intervention, technical malfunction, or other causes corrupt the administration, security, fairness, integrity, or proper operation of the Raffle.

Release of Liability. By entering into the Raffle, each Entrant agrees to: (a) be bound by these Official Rules; and (b) release, waive, discharge, covenant not to sue and indemnify the Organization and its Board of Directors (collectively, the "Released Parties") from any and all liability with respect to any injury, damage or loss that may occur, directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, from the participation or while preparing to participate in the Raffle.

Publicity Release. Each Winner shall grant (or decline at the Winner's discretion) the Organization and its designees and affiliates full permission, except where legally prohibited, to use such Winner's name, address (city and state only), photograph, voice and/or other likeness, and Cash Prize information for advertising, trade and promotional purposes without further compensation and without notice, review or approval, in all media now known or hereafter discovered, worldwide and in perpetuity. Each Winner shall execute all documents that the Organization may require to be signed in connection with its publicity release.

Disclaimer. The Organization in its sole discretion, reserves the right to disqualify any person tampering within the entry process or otherwise in violation of the Official Rules. The Organization further reserves the right to cancel, terminate or modify the Raffle for any reason, including, but not limited to any Raffle which is deemed to not be capable of completion as planned, infection by tampering, unauthorized intervention or technical failures of any sort, fraud, or acts of God.

The Released Parties are not responsible for: (1) Raffle Tickets which are lost, stolen, improperly issued, printing errors, counterfeited, illegible, given away, and altered or subject to other deficiencies which may limit an Entrant's ability to participate in or win any Raffle; (2) Entries or payments that are delayed, misdirected, undelivered, not fully captured, or garbled in a ISP, website, computer, telephone, cable or satellite modern or connection, handheld mobile device or any other computer equipment or connection, whether or not caused by site users, tampering, hacking, or by viruses, worms or malfunctions affecting network, server ISP, or any equipment or programming use in or associated with the Raffle; (3) Any other errors of any kind, whether human, typographical, printing, mechanical, or electronic in nature which relates to the Raffle, including without limitations errors in Raffle related materials or in the administration of the Raffle, such as errors in processing Tickets, determining a Winner, or announcing or delivery of Cash Prizes; or any portion of the Raffle that is compromised, then the Organization reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to suspend, modify or terminate the Raffle. Released Parties make no warranty, guaranty or representation of any kind concerning any Cash Prize and disclaimed any implied warranty. Failure to enforce any term of these Official Rules shall not constitute a waiver of that provision.

Governing Law. The Raffle and these Official Rules shall be subject to and governed by the laws of the State of Louisiana. If a court of competent jurisdiction finds that any provision of these Official Rules, or their application to particular persons or circumstances, is invalid or unenforceable to any extent, then the remainder of these

Official Rules shall remain enforceable to the fullest extent permitted by law. The venue for any cause of action arising out of the Raffle or these Official Rules shall be located in Lafayette Parish, Louisiana.
